Prof. Daniel Mark Siegel, New York, USA

Daniel M. Siegel, MD, is Clinical Professor of Dermatology at SUNY Downstate in Brooklyn, New York and is a former President and honorary member of the American Academy of Dermatology (AAD).

A graduate of Albany Medical College in New York, his residency in dermatology at Parkland Memorial Hospital in Dallas, Texas was followed by a fellowship in Mohs Micrographic Surgery and Dermatologic Surgery at Baylor College of Medicine in Houston, Texas. He also earned a Master of Science degree in management and policy from the W. Averell Harriman School for Management and Policy, State University of New York at Stony Brook.

Dr. Siegel currently serves as a member of the board of directors of the International League of Dermatologic Societies. He is a diplomate of the American Board of Dermatology and a fellow of many societies, and has served or serves on the board of directors for many of these societies. Dr. Siegel is a founding board member of debRA International. He is one of the 20 esteemed active members of the New York Dermatological Society.

Dr. Siegel has published over 150 articles and book chapters in major medical journals and textbooks. He is a reviewer, editor, or advisor for many dermatology journals. His expertise extends to a variety of area outside of "routine" dermatology including among many cutting-edge computer technology and botany. He also is an active participant representing AAD in the American Medical Association Specialty Society RVS Update Committee process.



Prof. George-Sorin Tiplica, Bucharest, Romania

Prof. George-Sorin Tiplica is Head of the 2nd Discipline of Dermatology at the “Carol Davila” University of Medicine and Pharmacy in Bucharest / Romania and Secretary General of the Romanian Medical Association.

He is actively involved in medical, research and administrative activities. He served as Research and Development Director of the Colentina Clinical Hospital and as Executive Director of the Romanian Society of Dermatology. His international activities linked him with the World Medical Association and the European Union of Medical Specialists / UEMS, acting as the Secretary General of the UEMS-MJC Wound Healing.

He served as representative for Romania in the Board of Directors of the European Academy of Dermatology and Venereology (EADV) and also in the EADV Executive Committee. He represents his country in the Board of IUSTI-Europe. Prof. Tiplica is President of the 34th IUSTI Congress that will be held in Bucharest in September 2020.

He published over 40 journal papers and book chapters in major medical journals and medical publishing houses. He is a reviewer for medical journals and section editor for the J Eur Acad Dermatol Venereol.

He is interested in inflammatory skin diseases, wound healing and in sexual transmitted infections. He developed the Dermato-cosmetology competence in Romania and is an advocate for the dermato-venereologists involvement in surgical procedures, organizing courses, seminars and work-shops on skin surgery.
